



## Thomas E. Filicky Memorial Scholarship

Mr. Filicky began his teaching career in 1967 for Plain Local Schools as the Vocational Electronics teacher at Oakwood High School and later GlenOak High School. He was honored as a Martha Holden Jennings Foundation Scholar in 1969 and was selected "Teacher of the Year" in 1991. In 2005, he was inducted into the Plain Local School's prestigious Hall of Distinction.

For many years Tom served as an advisor for Vocational Industrial Clubs of America; he mentored many young people helping them to gain apprenticeships, internships and career placements. During his 44 year tenure he supervised and directed the sound and lighting for Plain Local's performing arts programs and sporting events.

This annual scholarship is awarded to a GlenOak High School graduating senior who has demonstrated the high qualities and character that Mr. Filicky exemplified throughout his life as a teacher, mentor, leader and friend.
